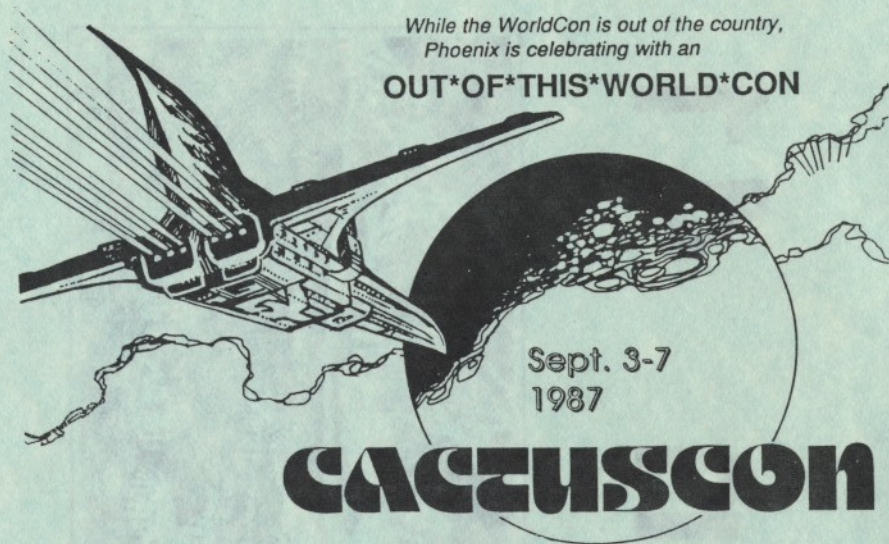

From the Chair

The first year of a Westercon committee's existence many of you out there wonder if it really exists, or if you are all alone in the wilderness. Well, I can't speak for all committees but our convention is alive and well. This year has been a year of quiet preparation behind the scenes. Indeed, we have signed hotel contracts for both the major hotels in downtown Phoenix and have staff for most departments. Final staffing in some departments has been held off because of the 1987 NASFiC, CactusCon, which will be held in Phoenix, Labor Day weekend. As many of you know ideas and staff seem to be generated (and some used up) by major conventions, so some staffing will be done after CactusCon. However, included in this PR are art show information, writer's workshop requirements, masquerade rules, and themed fashion show information. We have been busy. These are all areas that demand prior preparation for participants. Also included is information on some of the special things we have planned. The Westercon 41 committee and staff are working hard to make The Valley of the Sun WesterCon your best WesterCon ever.

Hotel

WesterCon 41 is proud to announce the addition of the Adams Hilton to our hotel block. Hyatt Regency with the Adams Hilton gives us 50,000 square feet of function space and 900 rooms per night (more room than we probably need but conventions tend to expand to fill available space). The Hyatt will be our main and party hotel. Suites on the third floor pool level will be reserved for bid parties first and other parties on a first come first served basis. Other suites in the hotel are available though the committee only. The Adams Hilton will be our **QUIET** hotel. There will be no parties allowed in the Hilton.

Weapons will be permitted in sheaths and holsters in both hotels. Projectile weapons, realistic firearms or any unprotected weapons will not be permitted except for Masquerade or Fashion Show with prior approval.

Room rates at the Hyatt are \$54 Single/Double \$59; Triple/Quad and at the Hilton \$56 Single/Double; \$61 Triple/Quad. Reservations can be made by calling the Hyatt at (602)252-1234; the Hilton at (602)257-1525. Reservation cards will be in PR3 out around 10/1/87.

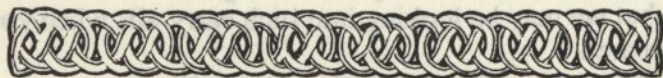


Special Art Exhibit

In 1979, at the last San Francisco WesterCon, George Barr and Jim Bearcloud proudly exhibited part of their wonderful art collection. They will be repeating that event for all of us in Phoenix. For those of you who were not at that show, the exhibit includes pieces by George, one of the field's best artists, and beautiful pieces by many other first-rate SF/F artists who have traded and sold pieces to George and Jim. In addition we all get the company of two of the West Coast's nicest people, who we don't see around conventions nearly enough. George has been busy doing work for TSR and *Weird Tales*.

Con Suite

Yes, there will be a con suite at Westercon 41. We have 3 rooms reserved on the third floor fronting the pool and garden courts. Munchies and soft drinks will be on tap throughout the day. In the evening beer will be served by a hotel bartender from 9 - 11. Having beer available this way is a compromise. We want you all to enjoy yourselves but due to the liability laws we are unable to get insurance, hence must depend on the hotel's. This, of course, costs a great deal, thereby necessitating the short hours. If the laws change, so will this policy.



Art Show

The 1988 WesterCon Art Show will be in the Hilton's Navajo Room on the second floor. This room held the 1982 WesterCon Art Show, so many of you are familiar with it. There will be 204 panel sides available for two dimensional art and about 20 tables for three dimensional work.

Rules for artists are now available with an SASE through our P.O. Box or from Ray Gish, 4424 S. Stanley Place, Tempe, AZ 85282. For those artists registered for CactusCon, you will be receiving a mailing after the convention to reserve space for WesterCon. Reservations for space will be on a first-come, first-served basis and we do not expect any space to be available at the door. Entry Fees will be \$5 for a 4X4 pegboard panel or 1/2 of a 6X2.5 table or the space to exhibit up to 8 pieces which ever requires the smaller space. Entry fees will double June 1, 1988. A 15% commission will be charged on all sales. Other rules basically follow the CactusCon rules unless we find a major glitch in them.

Control sheet, bid sheets and instructions plus any additional information will be sent to all registered artists. We would like the control sheets returned by June 15, 1988 if possible, so we can enter pieces of art in the computer. Corrections can always be made at the con, but the more we have done in advance the better everything will work.

Auctions are currently scheduled for Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Each auction will have its own minimum number of bids to go to auction: Saturday, two; Sunday, three; Monday, three. All auctions will close to bids the prior evening. All auction lists will be available at least two hours before scheduled auction time and will be posted in the Art Show office. All buyers must register with the Art Show. Please use the appropriate section of the Membership Application at the back of this PR to do so. Please do not give us your Mastercard or Visa number, but do give it to us when you pick up your bidder card at the show. There will be a 5% surcharge on all sales with a 5% discount for cash and checks.

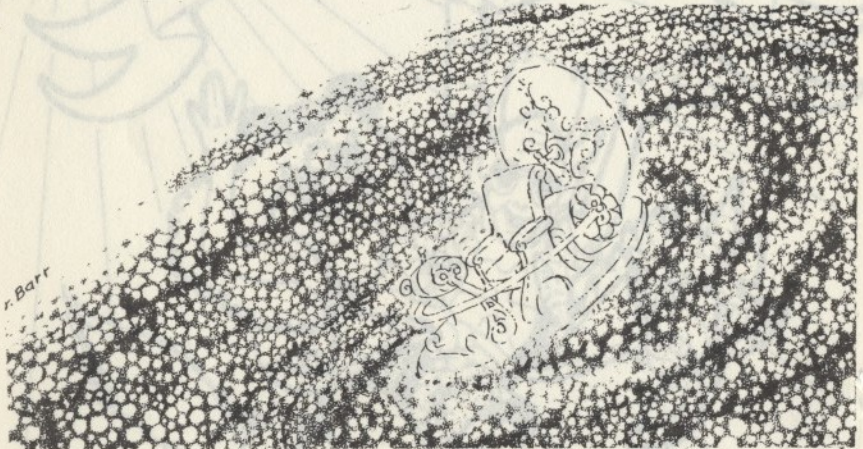

Writers' Workshop

The WesterCon 41 Writers' Workshop will be similar to the very successful writers' workshop held at Portland WesterCon in 1984.

Each participant shall submit one short story of about 1500-6000 words. The story must be in standard manuscript format — typed, double-spaced, on one side of the paper. Send 8 copies of the manuscript to Bill Vaughan at the Con P. O. Box number, by May 2, 1988. Participants will be divided into groups of about 6. At least 2 pros will work with each group.

Copies of the stories submitted by the participants in your group will be sent to you before. You should read and prepare to critique each of the stories at the Con. At the Con, your group will meet — amateurs and pros — for a round-robin Clarion-style review. No one not in the group will attend; this is not a spectator sport!

We are also interested in hearing from any pros who would like to participate in the workshop.

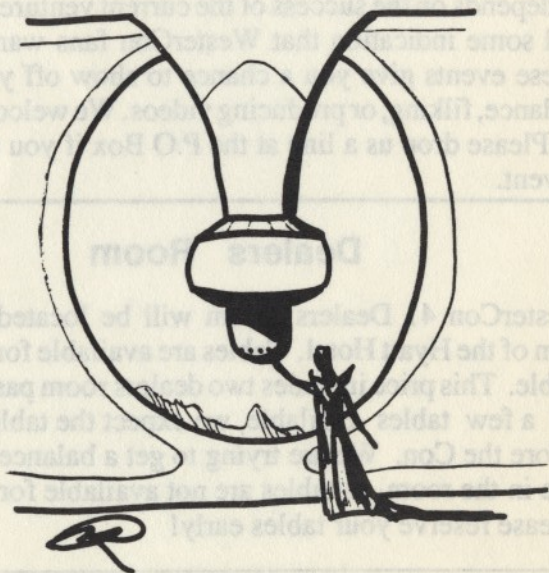
Roomate Matching Service

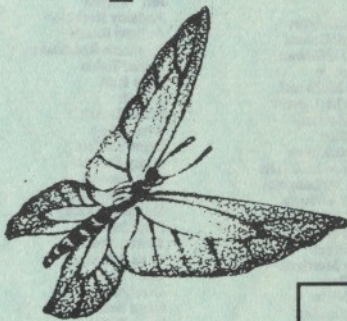
